About the Book Sale:

How do you get a chance at a prize? Point slips! Point slips provide your child and his/her grade credit throughout the August drive period. To receive credit, you must fill out a point slip. You need to fill out only one per box and put it inside the box. Point slips must be legible! Point slips are done on the honor system.
