FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS 2019-2020 ADMISSIONS LOTTERY CYCLE

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO HAAS HALL ACADEMY?

Any child entering grades 7-12 who is not expelled from another school may apply to attend Haas Hall Academy through the yearly Admissions Lottery.

WHAT IS THE HAAS HALL ACADEMY ADMISSIONS LOTTERY?

Each year Haas Hall Academy conducts a random, anonymous Admissions Lottery for each grade at each campus to determine which applicants are admitted to fill available seats. At the time of submission, each application is assigned a unique Lottery ID. The Lottery ID is used instead of names to identify applicants. During each Lottery drawing, the applications are assigned a random number. Those random numbers are then sorted into ascending order, which gives us the Lottery Results.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR ADMISSION TO HAAS HALL ACADEMY?

[Apply online](http://www.haashall.org/admissions/application) at www.haashall.org/admissions/application between September 4, 2018, and February 4, 2019. Families who do not have Internet access may visit any of our campuses to receive help with the application.

I APPLIED IN THE PAST AND DID NOT GAIN ADMISSION. DO I NEED TO RE-APPLY?

Yes. Applicants who do not gain admission during the Admissions Lottery must re-apply during the next Admissions Lottery cycle to be in the Admissions Lottery drawing for the following school year.

DO I NEED TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION IF MY SCHOLAR HAS A SIBLING AT HAAS HALL ACADEMY?

Yes. Anyone interested in attending Haas Hall Academy must submit an application. Siblings are not guaranteed a seat, but will receive priority at the campus their sibling attends. Preference is given to siblings of current scholars and children of faculty members.

WHEN IS THE ADMISSIONS LOTTERY DRAWING?

The 2019-2020 Admissions Lottery will take place at 6 p.m. Tuesday, February 26, 2019, at the Starr Scholar Center on the Fayetteville campus. Representatives from the Arkansas Department of Education and the public are invited to attend.

CAN WE VISIT HAAS HALL ACADEMY BEFORE THE ADMISSIONS LOTTERY?

Yes! Haas Hall Academy invites prospective scholars to Shadow A Scholar and spend a day at Haas Hall Academy prior to the Admissions Lottery drawing. Prospective scholars will attend classes alongside a current scholar and experience the unique Haas Hall Academy culture, schedule, and social environment. Shadows are by appointment only. Visit www.haashall.org/admissions/shadow-a-scholar to make an appointment.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE LOTTERY DRAWING?

Applicants who are selected will be notified by email the day following the Admissions Lottery drawing. The email will include a link to accept or decline the seat. Applicants who do not gain admission are put on the waiting list.

MY CHILD WAS OFFERED A SEAT AT MULTIPLE CAMPUSES. WE AREN'T SURE WHICH WILL WORK BEST FOR US. CAN WE ACCEPT MORE THAN ONE SEAT NOW AND MAKE A FINAL DECISION LATER?

No. If an applicant receives seat offers at multiple campuses, you may accept only one seat at one campus.

MY CHILD WAS OFFERED A SEAT AT ONE CAMPUS, BUT WE WOULD PREFER ANOTHER CAMPUS. IF I ACCEPT THE SEAT, WILL MY CHILD STAY ON THE WAITING LIST FOR THE OTHER CAMPUS?

No. Accepting a seat at one campus declines seat offers and potential seat offers at all other campuses. You will need to fill out a post-Lottery Application to be placed on the waiting list.

WHAT IS A POST-LOTTERY APPLICATION?

After the Admissions Lottery drawing we accept application for waiting list positions on a first-come, first-served basis. The applications are added to the bottom of the waiting list in the order we receive them.

ARE CAMPUS-TO-CAMPUS TRANSFERS PERMITTED?

No. Campus-to-campus transfers are not permitted. If a scholar at one Haas Hall Academy campus would like to attend another Haas Hall Academy campus, that scholar must apply during the Admissions Lottery for the campus they would like to attend.

DO YOU CHARGE TUITION?

Haas Hall Academy is an open-enrollment public charter school. We do not charge tuition.
