Grievance Procedures and Due Process:

If you wish to challenge the actions of the school's 504/IEP/ADA committee in regard to your child, you may ask for an opinion from one of the district's school level 504 coordinators. If you wish to file a complaint and/or continue your challenge regarding your child and the 504/IEP matters, you have the right to file a complaint with the districts 504/IEP/ADA coordinator, who will investigate the allegations to the extent warranted by the nature of the complaint in an effort to reach a prompt and equitable resolution.

You have the right to an impartial due process hearing with respect to the district's actions regarding your child's identification, evaluation, or educational placement, with opportunity for parental participation in the hearing and representation by an attorney. A hearing will be scheduled before an impartial hearing officer and you will be notified in writing of the date, time, and place for the hearing. If you disagree with the decision of the hearing officer, you have a right to seek a review of that decision before a court of competent jurisdiction.
